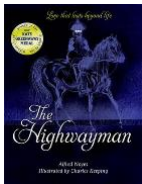


Year 5 Autumn Term: Anglo-Saxons

English

This term we will use these texts to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write using a range of genres.



Maths

As mathematicians we will develop our number and calculation skills. We will use these skills to demonstrate our deep understanding through a range of problem solving and reasoning activities.

Science

As scientists we will learn about: Materials and their properties. We will look at reversible and irreversible changes.

We will conduct an experiment into separating mixtures through filtration and investigate solubility.

We will learn about the chemist who invented Kevlar Stephanie Kwolek and explore how the property of materials affects their uses.

Geography

As a geographer we will use a range of maps and atlases to learn about the location of European capital cities and counties of the UK. We will investigate land use patterns and understand how these have changed over time.

History

As a historian we will learn about the Anglo-Saxons and how they fit into the chronology of British History. We will learn about Anglo-Saxon settlements, rulers and laws, before making comparisons to modern society.

Art

As artists we will appreciate the techniques used by Degas to create the effect of movement. We will explore how shading techniques can be used to create mood and feelings in sketches. Before creating a portrait based upon Beowulf.

D&T

As design technologists we will investigate a range of textiles used to create an Anglo-Saxon style game. We will learn how to use a range of stitches that can be used, before designing and make our own game.

Computing

In computing, we will be exploring how technology impacts our lives. We will learn the skills we need to use Google slides and will create a presentation showing all of our knowledge.

RE

The RE theme this term is Festivals and Symbols. We will learn about the festivals of Christmas, Diwali, Holi and Raksha Bandhan, and their impact on faith members using our key question 'How do People Express Their Faith?'

Music

As musicians we will listen to how music was composed during medieval times. We will learn how to play a short melody on a glockenspiel, before composing and performing our own song.

RSHE

Jigsaw themes this term are: Being Me in My World and Celebrating Difference.

PE

As sports people we will learn the skills needed to play invasion games and how to perform gymnastic balances and moves including forward and backward rolls.
