

Year 1 Spring Term: Where will the journey take us?

English

This term we will use these texts to support our learning. We will develop our phonics skills and write using a range of genres.



Maths

As mathematicians we will learn about numbers to 50 and develop our skills of addition and subtraction. We will also master our problem solving and reasoning skills within these areas.

Science

As scientists we will learn about animals.

We will also learn how to group them by their characteristics and will sort them into 6 animal groups: mammals, reptiles, amphibians, insects, fish and birds.

Geography

As a geographer we will learn about hot and cold places. We will look at globes, maps and atlases, as well as finding out about the equator.

History

As a historian we will learn about two famous people from the past: Captain James Cook and Amy Johnson.

Art

As artists we will appreciate the work of David Hockney and will use our observational drawing skills to draw different lines and shapes as well as use secondary and primary colours.

D&T

As design technologists we will investigate, design, make and review a sturdy product: a ship for Captain Cook.

Computing

In computing we will use skills and knowledge to manipulate an image in different ways.

RE

The RE theme is caring for the world. We will consider what it means to look after the people and world around us.

Music

As musicians we will use our voices and body parts in different ways to sing and help with rhythm.

PE

As sports people we will learn and practice skills needed for gymnastics and dance.
