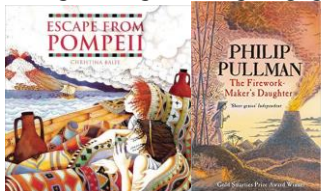


## Year 3 Spring Term: Italy

### Maths
