


# Year 6 Autumn Term: World War II

## Planned Enrichment Activities – Blitz trail walk around Hull

### English

This term we will use these texts to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write using a range of genres.



### Maths

As mathematicians we will develop our understanding of place value in numbers up to ten million.

We will develop our understanding of formal written methods of calculation for the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). We will use a range of calculation strategies to solve multi-step problems.

### Science

As scientists we will learn about: Humans, including the respiratory system and the circulatory system and how light travels.

We will conduct an investigation into how exercise impacts our heart rate and undertake the dissection of a lamb's heart.

We will learn about the scientist Thomas Edison and explore how light allows us to see.

### Geography

As a geographer we will learn about the location of countries in the world and the location of rivers in the UK and why cities are located near rivers. We will use os maps to understand how to use 6 figure grid references.

### History

As a historian we will learn about World War II using a range of sources. We will focus on the affect the war had on the city of Hull and how it changed the city.

### Art

As artists we will appreciate the work of Gustav Klimt. We will explain the style and techniques in our own work and how it has been influenced by Klimt. We will use mixed media to create a specific effect.

### D&T

As design technologists we will investigate a range of pies, before making our own Woolton pie. We will learn how to work within a budget (wartime rationing) and use this to substitute ingredients.

### Computing

In computing we will use be developing our programming skills using Turtle, to create our own computer game.

### RE

The RE theme this term is Justice and Freedom. We will be exploring the lives of people who have suffered injustices, using our key question 'Is it Fair?'

### Music

As musicians we will listen to a range of war time songs. We will listen and appreciate the musicians and the style of music throughout the wartime period.

### RSHE

Jigsaw themes this term are: Belonging and Celebrating Difference. We will be having a visit from IMPS to learn about injury prevention.

### PE

As sports people we will learn the skills needed to play invasion games and how to perform gymnastic moves including forward and backward rolls.

### French

In French we will be learning to speak and write basic greetings and identify objects in the classroom using Rigolo
