Literacy

We will be applying our knowledge of the 'special friend' sounds (digraphs) such as: 'ay' 'ee', 'igh' and 'ow' in our writing.

Maths

This half term we will be learning about shape, doubling, halving and sharing.

Physical Development

We will be focussing on moving with coordination and control. As well as sequencing a series of movements.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term we will be learning to give focused attention to activities and follow instructions involving several ideas or actions

Communication and Language
