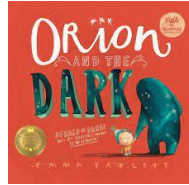
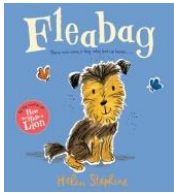


Year 2 Summer Term
