English

This term, as writers we will be using 'The Wolves in the Walls' to inspire us to write a diary entry, a non-chronological report and some descriptive writing.
As readers, we will be reading 'The Iron Man' to develop our comprehension and fluency skills.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will learn about place value in 4 digit numbers and develop our skills of addition, subtraction. We will also master our problem solving and reasoning skills within these areas.



Science

As scientists, we will learn all about light and explore darkness, reflections and shadows.
We will also learn about how sound is made, travels and how we hear.

Geography

As geographers, we will develop our understanding of using atlases and maps. We will learn about the countries of Europe and the capital cities.

History

As historians, we will learn how the Romans have influenced Britain and we will use our understanding of chronology to begin to develop an understanding of the different periods in British history.

Art

As artists, we will be looking at the work of Henri Matisse. We will be combining different colours to print our own pieces of work.

As design technologist, we will explore how to join pieces of materials using the back stitch. We will then use a template to create Roman sandals.

Computing

In computing, we will develop our understanding of the internet. We will learn the importance of evaluating content online and the importance of being safe online.
