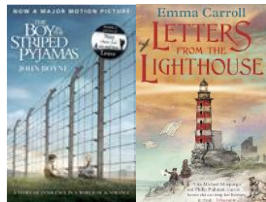


Year 6 Autumn Term: World War II

Enrichment: Visit to Eden Camp / Museum in a Box project

Literacy

This term we will use these texts to support our learning in reading and writing. We will develop our comprehension skills and write using a range of genres.



Maths

As mathematicians we will develop our understanding of place value in numbers up to ten million.

We will develop our understanding of formal written methods of calculation for the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). We will use a range of calculation strategies to solve multi-step problems.

Science

As scientists we will learn about: Humans, including the circulatory system, and about how light travels.

We will investigate how exercise impacts our heart rate and talk about the negative effects of drugs, alcohol and poor diet.

We will learn about the scientist Thomas Edison and explore how light allows us to see.

Geography

As geographers we will learn about the location of countries in the world and the location of rivers in the UK and why cities are located near rivers. We will use OS maps to understand how to use 6 figure grid references.

History

As historians we will learn about World War II using a range of sources. We will focus on the effect the war had on the city of Hull and how it changed the city.

Art

As artists we will appreciate the work of Paul Nash. We will explore the style and techniques in our own work to sketch and paint landscapes, using colours to create mood and feeling.

D&T

As designers we will investigate a combination of stitching and embroidery techniques in textiles. We will research, practice, design, make and evaluate a cushion.

Computing

In Computing we will be developing we will learn about Computer Systems and Networks, and we will create a Webpage.

RE

The RE theme this term is Justice and Freedom. We will be exploring the lives of people who have suffered injustices, using our key question 'Is it Fair?'

Music

As musicians, we will sing, explore, create and perform music from different genres, commenting on our likes and dislikes.

RSHE

Jigsaw themes this term are: Belonging and Celebrating Difference. We will discuss our rights and responsibilities as well as empathy.

PE

As sports people we will learn the skills needed to play invasion games and how to perform gymnastic moves including forward and backward rolls.

French

In French, we will learn to speak about ourselves and our families as well as the phonics needed to speak fluently.
