Year 2 Spring Term


Enrichment activities- local area walk, visit to The Streetlife Museum

English

This term we will use these texts to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write using a range of genres.







Maths

As mathematicians we will learn multiplication and division. We will use and extend our knowledge of 2,5 and 10 times tables. In outer numeracy we will learn about 2d and 3d shapes and their properties.

Science

As scientists we will continue our learning about animals including humans and how they grow and survive.

We will also learn about what plants need to grow and be healthy.

Geography

As a geographer we will learn about features of our local area. We will create a simple map and talk about the features we like and dislike.

History

As a historian we will learn about life of rich and poor children in Victorian times. We will learn about Queen Victoria and how she changed Britain.

<u>Art</u>

As artists we will appreciate the work of Picasso. We will look at the use of colour and shape and create a collage portrait of Queen Victoria influenced by the artist.

D&T

As design technologists we will make a wheeled vehicle. We will investigate axles in wheeled toys before designing, making and evaluating our work.

Computing

In computing we will use skills and knowledge to create and debug algorithms to instruct programmable toys.

RE

The RE theme is believing. We will consider the importance of belief in different religions.

Music

As musicians we will listen to music and recognise the pitch and tempo and how this influences how we feel.
