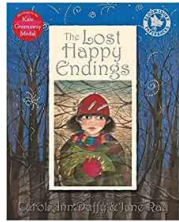


Year 6 Spring Term: The Vikings

Planned Enrichment Activities – Viking Day

English

This term we will use these texts and other stimuli to support our learning. We will develop our reading comprehension skills and write for a range of purposes.



Maths

As mathematicians we will develop our understanding of parts and wholes. We will develop our understanding of the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages and then move on to looking at pie charts in statistics.

We will then move onto geometry and measure.

Science

As scientists we will learn about light. We will gain an understanding of how light travels and how the eye sees. We will investigate reflection and refraction. We will learn about the work of the scientist and inventor Thomas Edison.

We will move onto learning about Electricity, looking at components of a circuit and variations.

Geography

As geographers we will learn about climate zones and their significance, with a particular focus on the Arctic and Antarctic Circles.

We will then look at the impact Climate Change is having on these parts of the world.

History

As historians we will learn about when, why and how the Vikings invaded Britain and where they came from. We will gain an understanding of life during the Viking era and how Britain became a unified country at this time.

Art

As artists we will be focusing on portraiture. We will look at the artwork of Gustav Klimt and learn how he used colour, and how he was influenced by patterns in nature.

Design Technology

We will research, design, make and evaluate a product which includes electrical systems and programme a computer to monitor and control it

Computing

In computing we will create a website with a navigation path, considering copyright.

We will also explore variables in games while developing our programming skills.

RE

The RE theme this term is Living a Faith.

Key Question: What gives a sense of identity and belonging?

Music

As musicians we will listen to an evaluate songs. We will learn about musical notation and compose our own music.

RSHE

Jigsaw themes this term are: Healthy Me and Relationships. We will learn how to keep our bodies and minds healthy.

PE

As sports people we will learn the skills needed to perform a range of dance movements and develop our teamwork skills in Outdoor and Adventurous Activities.

French

In French we will be learning to have simple conversations about ourselves, learning the names of body parts and animals.
