English

This term we will use *The Secret Garden* and *A Midsummer Night's Dream* to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write using a range of genres.



Maths

As mathematicians, we will develop our understanding of shape and perimeter as part of our geometry unit. We will also understand how to interpret graphs and charts, and display data collected in a range of ways.

Science

As scientists, we will learn about space and the solar system. We will gain an understanding of the planets in our solar system in relation to Earth.



Geography

As geographers, we will carry out a fieldwork study of leisure activities in our local area, understanding how these have changed over time.

History

As historians, we will know how the Benin civilisation has impacted on the world and how this contrasts with British History.

Art

As artists, we will be inspired by William Morris. We will create a sculpture, selecting appropriate tools and equipment to create a final piece based on the work of Morris.

As design technologists, we will design and make a mechanical toy that features systems such as pulleys and gears.

Computing

In computing, we will understand what vector drawings are, using them to create our own project.

RE

The RE theme this term is 'Pilgrimage'. We will study why different religious groups take part in pilgrimage in their lives.
